Please plan to join us at Camp Ida-Haven, McCall, Idaho for our seventh annual IDAVOAD/Citizen Corps conference. This conference will allow all statewide community based organizations to cooperate, coordinate, collaborate and communicate for a more effective emergency response in any disaster.

WORKSHOPS

The focus of the conference will be Perspective of Emergency Management. Who are your partners, what will emergency managers be asking of your agency in a disaster? How can we effectively work together? How does a disaster response happen from the event to long term recovery? These are issues that we will be exploring at this year's conference.

Non-profits, faith organizations, community organizations, emergency management, other agencies that may assist in disaster recovery

ACCOMMODATIONS

Camp Ida-Haven is run by the Seventh Day Adventist Church. It is located five miles from downtown McCall, Idaho. Since this is a church camp, **Guests must provide their own towels, toiletries and bedding.** Separate men and women's groups are in cabins and lodges. We will accommodate married couples where possible. Chairs are available, but you may want to bring your favorite camp chair for the meetings.

Meals will be in a cafeteria. Meat, fish, and poultry are not served. Dairy products, including milk, cheese and eggs are used. If you have special dietary needs, please let us know at least two weeks in advance and we will try to accommodate you. Help with dishes and vacuuming of rooms before departure will be expected.
